The college offers two regular courses in B.Com, BCA and a specialized course in BBA Aviation Management. At Hindustan First Grade College, we take immense pride in the fact that our students receive the best quality education. This is made possible by following high standards of teaching and learning. Our excellence is not just confined to the classroom; we are also notable active in conducting conferences, workshops, seminars, guest lectures and other co-curricular activities. These activities expose students to aspects beyond curriculum, thus adding high value to their professional success.

Department Staff:

The faculties of HFGC have contributed enormously for the eminence and reputation of the college. They have been pursuing research, presenting papers, publishing articles and writing books and have also been associated with academic and other organizations. In the recent past, Dr. C. J. Priya, Dr. Harshavardhana B and Dr. Gururaja Rao have completed their doctoral research and were awarded Ph.D degrees. We have 19 teaching staff and 5 non teaching staff on roll. Out of 19 teaching staff, 3 faculties were awarded Ph.D., degree and 10 faculties have cleared UGC-NET/KSET exams. Teachers have also organized and participated in various conferences and workshops and thereby motivate and empower the students to be lifelong learners, critical thinkers and productive members of an ever changing global society.

Students’ activities

Our students were provided with number of opportunities this year. Many students have excelled in individual achievements by participating in various intra & inter collegiate events. Competitions and activities organized offered opportunities for students to learn the values of teamwork, individual and group responsibility and a sense of culture and community. The college arranged an Industrial Visit for the students to provide an exposure about practical working environment. The Commerce & Management students visited RUDSETI (Rural Development & Self Employment Training Institute) where they gained an exposure about practical working of an EDP and how to be self-employed by undergoing a formal training. 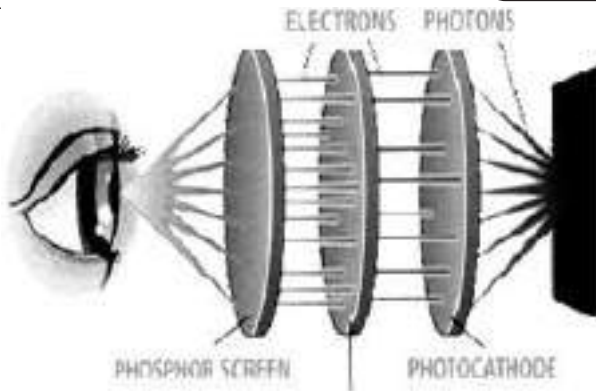

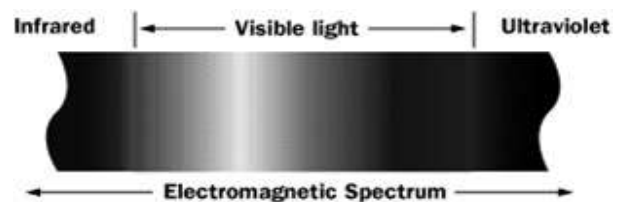

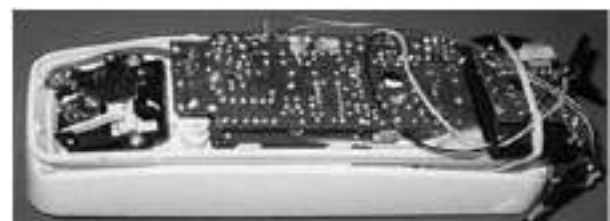
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History of Social Computing

We are in the world of digital era. After civilisation for business purpose people used barter system, later coins came into existence then the paper notes came into existence. Money created a biggest revolution in the field of business. The present trend is to do business by using digital cash and digital assets. Digital money became very popular as it does all the work of conventional money. It is used for buying goods, pay for services and we can exchange it for other currencies. They are centralised and there is no geographical boundaries. It can be transacted from anywhere in the world.

Digital currency is electronic money where it does not exist physically but exists only in digital world. Crypto currency is a type of Digital currency.

The concept of having digital asset is an innovative aspect. In 1998 the idea of digital currency was first introduced by Wei Dai who was a Computer engineer who had his Alma mater at University of Washington. He first came with this idea by publishing it in a paper where he discussed “B-money”. Later on in the same year there was one more attempt made by Nick Szabo who was also a computer engineer from the same University who is considered as a block chain pioneer. He wanted to introduce decentralised digital currency called ‘Bitgold’. Both Wei Dai and Nick Szabo were not successful in launching it officially.

The credit goes to “Satoshi Nakamoto” from Japan, who was the first person in succeeding in the launch of the digital currency officially. He started his research work in the year 2007 with his colleague and registered a website in the name bitcoin.org.



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He invented a Cryptocurrency called BITCOIN in the year 2008. He describes it as a “Bitcoin : A Peer -to- Peer electronic cash system”. He continued his research activity by collaborating with other software developers. Bitcoin was structured by record -keeping and security system called block chain.

A fact of “Satoshi Nakamoto” is quite interesting. “Satoshi Nakamoto” is a Pseudonym. Satoshi means a small unit of bitcoin. Nakamoto is a surname used in Japanese. It is believed that he was born on 5th April, 1975. His intention was to create digital cash and he did his successful research in digital crypto currency. Nakamoto has not disclosed any personal information. It is told that he is a 37 years old male lived in Japan. But bitcoins are labelled in Japanese. Some people consider Nakamoto may be a team or group of people.

Crypto currency is a digital or virtual currency that is secured by cryptography. ‘Crypto means various encryption algorithms & cryptographic techniques. The word crypto currency is derived from the encryption techniques which are used for network security. Crypto currencies make use of cryptographic which are very complex coding system that encrypt the data and transfers them

into secured units of exchange. Crypto currency developers construct these protocols in such a way where it is very difficult to duplicate and it protects the currencies.

In simple words crypto currency is a medium of exchange which uses internet and cryptographic functions to do financial transactions. Crypto currencies are not controlled by any centralised authority. It can be sent to two people using public & private keys. Processing fees are charged. There are different types of digital currencies like Ethereum, Ripple, Litecoin, Tether, Libra, Monero, Ven, Darkcoin, Peercoin, Dogecoin, Primecoin, Chinacoin and the most popular is Bitcoin.

Bitcoin is a crypto currency. It is a decentralised digital currency without a central

bank that can be sent on peer-to-peer bitcoin network. Bitcoins are stored in bitcoin wallets. NOTE: - A 30-qubit-quantum computer would equal the processing power of a conventional computer that could run teraflops (trillions of floating-point operations per second).

A quantum computer is any device for computation that makes direct use of distinctively quantum mechanical phenomena, such as superposition and entanglement, to perform operations on data.

A quantum computer using Shor’s algorithm could achieve the same feat in just 10 seconds, with a modest 1 million operations per second. That’s the power of quantum computers: 300 trillion years versus

DISTRIBUTED CLOUD

Distributed cloud systems promise to bring about a new era of cloud computing. These systems distribute public cloud services to several locations outside a provider's data centers, but the provider still controls them. Cloud providers take care of cloud service architecture, governance, operations, updates, and delivery. Data centers can be anywhere, latency and data sovereignty challenges are reduced. Distributed cloud services offer the



benefit of a public cloud service with those of a private cloud.

A distributed cloud refers to having computation, storage, and networking in a micro-cloud located outside the centralized cloud. Examples of a distributed cloud include both fog computing and edge computing. ... A distributed cloud also processes data in real-time.

Distributed Cloud examines a major evolution in cloud computing where the applications, platforms, tools, security, management and other services are physically shifting from a centralized data center model to one in which the services are distributed and delivered at the point of need. The point of need can extend into customer data centers or all the way to the edge devices.

A distributed cloud refers to the distribution of public cloud services to different locations outside the cloud providers' data centers,

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while the originating public cloud provider assumes responsibility for the operation, governance, maintenance and updates. This represents a significant shift from the centralized model of most public cloud services and will lead to a new era in cloud computing.

Concept of Distributed Cloud:

Gartner expects distributed cloud computing will happen in three phases:

% Phase 1: A like-for-like hybrid mode in which the cloud provider delivers services in a distributed fashion that mirror a subset of services in its centralized cloud for delivery in the enterprise.



% Phase 2: An extension of the like-for-like model in which the cloud provider teams with third parties to deliver a subset of its centralized cloud services to target communities through the third-party provider. An example is the delivery of services through a telecommunications

provider to support data sovereignty requirements in smaller countries where the provider does not have data centers.

% Phase 3: Communities of organizations share distributed cloud substations. We use the term "substations" to evoke the image of subsidiary stations (like branch post offices) where people gather to use services.

Cloud customers can gather at a given distributed cloud substation to consume cloud services for common or varied reasons if it is open for community or public use. This improves the economics associated with paying for the installation and operation of a distributed cloud substation. As other companies use the substation, they can share the cost of the installation.

This can deliver major improvements in performance and reduce the risk of global network-related outages, as well as support occasionally connected scenarios. By 2024,

most cloud service platforms will provide at least some services that execute at the point of need.

There is a seismic shift that is about to reshape enterprise IT. Due to key trends like AI and IoT, applications and data as encapsulated in their supporting infrastructure are increasingly being spread across multiple datacenters – some on premises and some in multiple clouds – and edge sites.

This is a sharp demarcation from today's IT environment, where organizations rely largely on traditional datacenters and individual clouds. According to Gartner, over half of enterprise-generated data will be produced and processed outside traditional datacenters or a single centralized cloud by 2022, compared to just 10 percent today. By 2025, they forecast that number will climb as high as 75 percent to 90 percent.

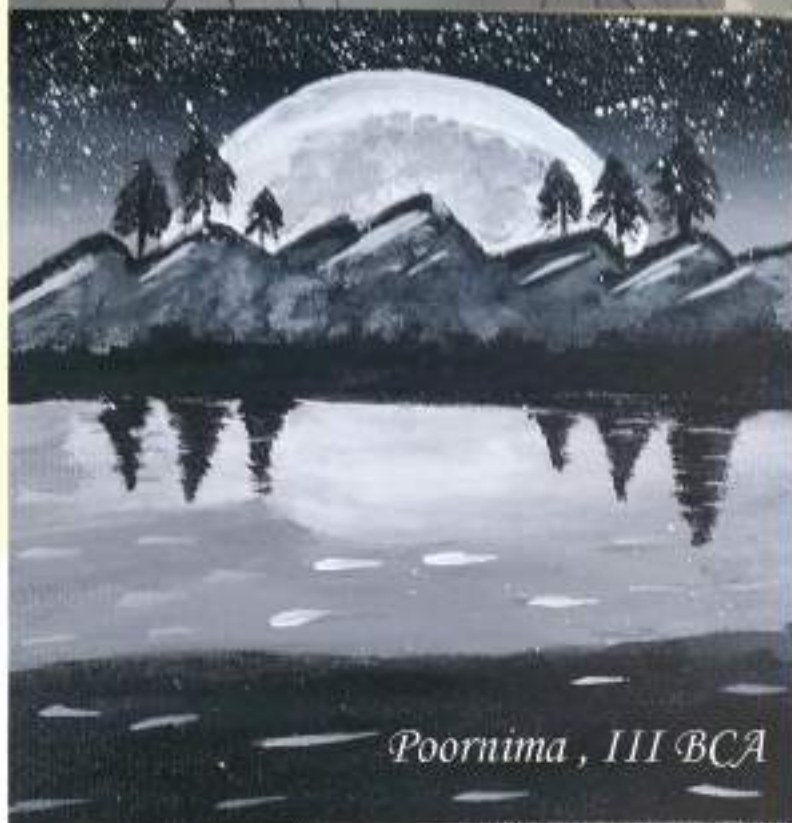
