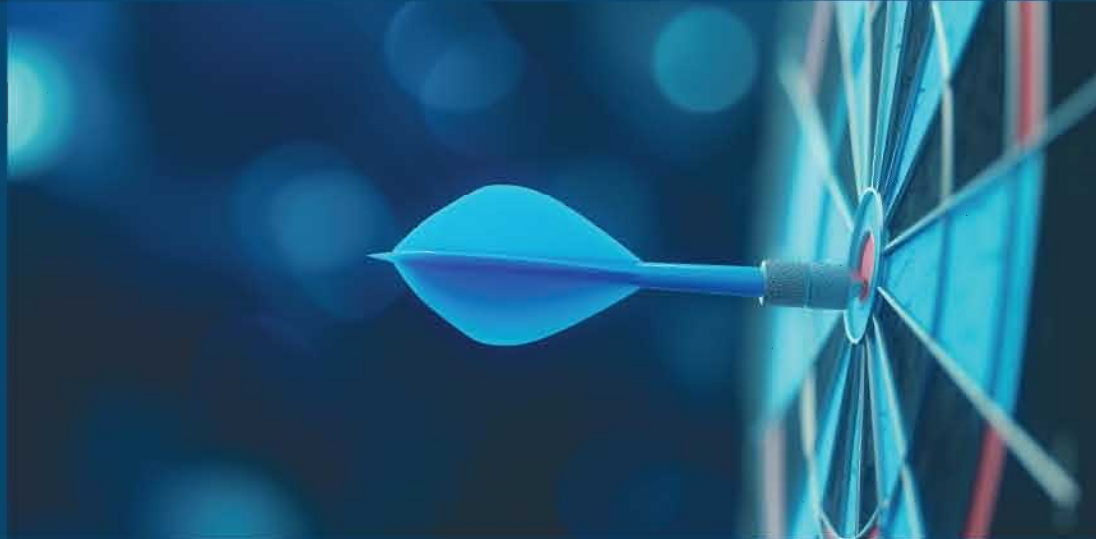

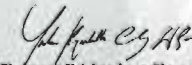

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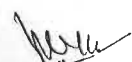

The Visionary Founder: Dr. K. C. G. Verghese

An extraordinary leader, educator, avid aviator, and philanthropist our beloved Founder Chairman Late Dr. K C G Verghee played a pivotal role in pioneering technical and aviation education in India. He strived to create a platform that encourages students to pursue their dreams in the field of aviation and authored his own autobiography naming it “Wheels and Wings: which portrays his passion towards aviation industry.

In the early sixties, he realized the need for an institution that offers non-formal technical education and his unwavering perseverance led him to establish the Hindustan Engineering Training Centre (HETC) in the year 1966, which eventually laid foundation for the successful evolution of the Hindustan Group of Institutions, offering world class education to over 23000 students in various stream of study.

Long before our Honorable Prime Minister spoke about Start Up India, and Made in India, the Chairman was promoting the entrepreneurial mindset through E-Cells and Technology Business Incubators on various campuses of the

Group. These institutions were also among the first to set up language laboratories for foreign languages, invite industry collaboration, and offer digital courses. He has travelled extensively to USA, Europe, UK, Asia, Africa, Middle East and Russia to promote educational partnerships.

Even as he steered the institutions of higher learning, he became increasingly aware of the need to offer pedagogy of the highest quality to school going children. 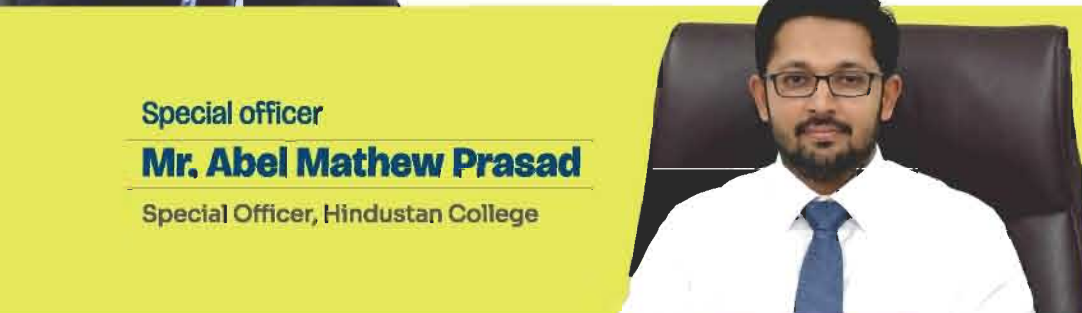

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Teaching THE GEN-Z

The fellow readers are hereby informed that teaching Generation Z (Gen-Z) has become increasingly challenging/tougher over time. This observation is based on personal experience, and I acknowledge I may be mistaken, as people have different perspectives. When I use the word "tougher," I am not implying that I lack confidence or expertise; rather, I am referring to the growing gap in how people perceive things. Viewing the generational divide as unavoidable is a reasonable perspective; however, treating it as something entirely separate can raise issues.

The concept of the generational gap has existed since the **beginning** of human existence. It is not new to society. The demographic cohort of an era that follows Millennials (1981-1996) and precedes Generation Alpha (2010-2024) is **eneration Z** (1996-2010). Here, numerous obstacles must be confronted, encompassing their cognition, perception, management, reactions, comprehension, and handling.
