With an intention of inspiring many young minds, its an attempt by the Newsletter Team to share the life history of Dr.K.C.G.Vergheese, the founder of Hindustan Group of Institutions (Based on Wheels and Wings – His Autobiography).



Dr. K.C.G VERGHESE

Some people are great because of their birth, some are made great by circumstances, and some become great through their vision, abilities and perseverance. Dr. KCG Vergheese belongs to the third category.

Koodathinalil Chacko Gee Vergheese , popularly known as Dr KCG was born as a sixth child to

Mathai Chacko and Sosamma on 20th June 1940 in Kunnam, a small village situated near the secret river Pamba in the Pathanamthitta district of Kerala. The parents of Dr. KCG had 8 sons and 5 daughters

The seven brothers of Dr.K.C.G were named as Mathew, Jacob, Thomas, John, Abraham, Philip and Samuel. Annamma, Thankamma, Saramma, Susan and Leela were sisters . Abraham and Philip were the twin siblings.

Dr. K.C.G.was brought up in Kunnam, in an ancestral home that was built amidst thick forest at Kunnam. He had wonderful memories of the adventurous childhood.

Kunnam had a marthoma Church as well as a school. The school was started by Mr.Mathai Chacko and his friends with the assistance from other families in the locality.

During his teens Dr. K.C.G.Vergheese, decided to participate in the cross

country race. A frail and thin who was not much of a sprinter proved to be a strong contender among the contestants. He never wanted to quit without giving it a try. The strong-willed teen ager emerged as the winner of the cross country race.

With the influence and training of Sosamma teacher, Dr Vergheese developed the art of public speaking. The young teacher from Kottayam not only inspired, but also vigorously trained him and encouraged to participate in in various competitions at inter School events. Dr. Vergheese secured second rank in in the SSLC examination. As his mother had a strong belief that, education outside the state could develop one's personality; and father, being liberal in the matter of education, made Dr.Vergheese to relocate from Kerala for his further studies.

FRESHER'S DAY





NEW ARRIVAL IN MARKET - VIVO Z1 Pro



Vivo Z1 Pro will again go on sale in India on 26th July 2019. The Vivo offering with triple rear cameras and includes a full HD+ display with a hole-punch and the snap dragon 712 SoC ticking under the hood. The phone also comes with a host of gaming-centric features and supports 18W fast charging to top its large 5,000mAh battery. The Vivo Z1 Pro starts at Rs.14,990 for the base 4 GB RAM + 64GB storage variant, while the higher-end 6GB RAM + 64 GB storage version is priced at Rs. 16,990. The phone's top-end 6 GB RAM +128 GB storage variant carries a price tag of Rs. 17,990.

The Vivo Z1 Pro runs Funtouch OS 9 based on Android 9 Pie and features a 6.53 – inch full HD+(1080*2340 pixels) display with a 19.5:9 aspect ratio. It is paired with Adreno 616 GPU and megapixel primary sensor with a f/1.78 lens+ an 8-megapixel secondary sensor with a 120 – degree super wide angle f/2.2 lens+ a 2-megapixel tertiary sensor with an f/2.4 lens. Selfies are handled by a 32-megapixel selfie camera that comes with an f/2.0 lens.


