## HINDUSTAN PREMIER LEAGUE BOX CRICKET TOURNAMENT






On occasion of National Sports Day, II B.Com students of HFGC conducted 'Hindustan Premier League Box Cricket Tournament' on 25.08.2021.




#### WEBINAR ON "FINANCIAL PLANNING"


#### WEBINAR ON "BUILDING AUTHENTIC SELF CONFIDENCE"






