WEBINAR ON 'PSYCHOLOGY OF SELF TRANSFORMATION'



Dr. K.C.G.'s corner

Recap: The beauty of the Himalayan mountain ranges cannot be described in words. The Government of Nepal sent a delegation to HIET to invite Dr.K.C. Verghese to visit Katmandu. They wanted to finalize a deal for training their army officers in HIET. They were flying at 30,000 feet when the pilot announced the sighting of the world's summit. The clouds had dispersed and they could get a clear view of Everest.



In 1977, Dr. K.C.G. Verghese and Mrs. Elizabeth went on a world tour. They visited the Southeast Asian countries, spent a few days in Hong Kong, Japan, Hawaii and then proceeded to New York, where their cousin Mr. Jacob and his wife Alice received them and drove to their house in Schenectady. They stayed there for two weeks, visited the Niagara Falls, the Empire State Building and the World Trade Centre, and had great fun.

New York is a fascinating place. Finally, it was time to return home. Jacob drove them to Kennedy Airport to take the flight to London. They reached the airport late in the afternoon and Jacob drove away after dropping off.

When they boarded the TWA aircraft,t there were at least twenty-five airplanes ahead of Mr. And Mrs. Verghese, waiting for clearance for take-off. Every time a plane took off, they could hear the thunderous roar and they hoped their turn would come soon. Finally, their plane was taxiing forward and they thought they would soon be airborne. But something dramatic happened. Dr. Verghese was sitting by the window, admiring the glistening lights of New York City, all of a sudden the lights went off and the entire city was plunged into darkness.

They were in New York, the financial capital of the world. The pilot announced that because of a major power failure, the city is in darkness and no aircraft would be allowed to take off and the ATC had instructed him to keep the aircraft away from the runway. He moved the plane from the main runway to a parking spot. Later they learnt that the main atomic power station, which supplies electricity to New York City, had failed.

Flights bound for New York had been diverted to other airports. All the

stranded airplanes lined up for take-off, and soon they were on our way to London. When they arrived at the hotel where they had reserved accommodation, the Reception Manager very politely informed them that their room had been allotted to another guest as they had failed to show up. The hotel had no other rooms available. The hotels were invariably full and they went from pillar to post, looking for a place to rest.

They must have knocked at the doors of some fifty hotels before they finally found a room with a leaky roof. A bucket was placed to capture the falling droplets and they had to be content with that. The morning newspapers reported the New York blackout. Mr.Jacob was flabbergasted when Dr. Verghese called him from London to say that they had spent the whole night sitting inside the aircraft.

New York has always stood as a monument to the glory of modern civilization. It has a beauty that is beyond imagination and a vibrant quality that no other city in the world can match.

Dr. Verghese and Mrs. Verghese visited Japan in the nineties. One day they decided they would take a ride on the bullet train. They boarded the train at Tokyo and several minutes later they got off at a relatively obscure location. When they went to the counter to purchase their return tickets, Dr. Verghese realized that he did not have enough money. So they went in search of a bank to cash their traveller's cheques.

It was a pleasant surprise when they found banks, moneychangers, travel agencies, restaurants and shopping malls, all in the same building. The railway station was located on the fourth floor of a multi-storeyed building. They went to the ground floor where the banks were situated and en cashed the traveller's cheques. When they returned to the platform, they found that the last train had gone.

After several failed attempts to communicate, Dr. Verghese spied a man wearing a tie and went over to him. They followed his advice and soon they were back in Tokyo. For this they had to take a boat cruise on the mighty River Brahmaputra for six days. In some places the river was several kilometres wide and they felt they were in the middle of the ocean. The Brahmaputra is said to be the most treacherous of Indian rivers. Flash floods and strong undercurrents, harsh terrain and wild animals make the river a nightmare for the inexperienced traveller. Anyone who falls into the water will disappear without a trace. In some clearings, tigers and lions are believed to be lying in wait for the unwary boat people. Dr. Verghese wondered how they could say that they don't have enough drinking water in this country.
