Her presentation provided valuable guidance on the various paths students can pursue, offering a clear vision of the exciting prospects ahead.

B C Shadakshari Swamy, Managing Director of Agamin Group of Companies, Bangalore** delivered an insightful address on the evolution of technology. Date: 06/08/2024

Overview of the Aviation Industry

Capt. Anjith, OFAA explored the vast scope within the aviation industry, highlighting various sectors such as commercial aviation, military aviation, and general aviation, and how each plays a crucial role in global connectivity and economic growth.

Career Opportunities in the Aviation Industry

Dangerous Goods and Classification of Dangerous Goods



The final session of the day, led by Mr. Rijo Johnson, delved into the crucial topic of dangerous goods in aviation. The session explained the various categories of dangerous goods, the risks associated with them, and the stringent regulations governing their transportation.

Cabin Crew Management

Ms. Sneha Pillai, Aviation Faculty, Hindustan College led a session on the essential aspects of cabin crew management. Students were introduced to the challenges faced by cabin crew, such as dealing with difficult passengers and managing in-flight medical emergencies. The session also emphasized the importance of teamwork, communication, and maintaining a professional demeanour at all times.

Safety and Security: Fundamentals of Aviation Safety, Security Protocols, and Regulatory Frameworks

Capt. Riche, OFAA conducted an in-depth session on aviation safety and security. Students learned about the various security protocols in place to protect passengers, crew, and aircraft from threats. The session also explored the regulatory frameworks established by international bodies such as the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), which ensure standardized safety and security practices across the industry.

Date: 08/08/2024

Importance of IATA Certification on Customer Handling & Career Opportunities

Ms. Daisy Fathima, OFAA highlighted the significance of International Air Transport Association (IATA) certification



in the aviation industry. The discussion focused on how IATA certification enhances customer handling practices and opens up career opportunities in various sectors of aviation. Students learned about the different IATA certification programs available and the value they add to a professional's credentials. The session also touched on the importance of customer service excellence in aviation, emphasizing how it contributes to the overall success of airlines and other aviation-related businesses.

Grooming

In the afternoon, students participated in a grooming session, separately for boys & girls. Ms. Daisy Fathima conducted the session for the female students. The focus was on personal grooming and professional appearance, which are critical aspects of working in the aviation industry. Students were guided on appropriate attire, grooming standards, and the importance of maintaining a polished and professional image. The session also included tips on how to present oneself confidently and effectively during interviews and professional settings.

Date: 09/08/2024

FN Session : Air Traffic Control

Mr. Vignesh, OFAA delivered an informative session on Air Traffic Control (ATC), a vital component of aviation operations. The session covered the basics of ATC, including the responsibilities of air traffic controllers, the technology used in air traffic management, and the procedures followed to ensure safe and efficient aircraft movements. Students learned about the different types of airspace, the role of radar and communication systems, and the coordination required between pilots and controllers to manage air traffic. The session provided a deeper understanding of the complexities involved in maintaining the safety and order of aircraft in the sky.

AN Session : Flight Simulator Experience

In the afternoon, students had the opportunity to experience a flight simulator, led by Capt. Chintan. This hands-on session allowed students to apply theoretical knowledge in a practical setting, simulating various flight scenarios and understanding the decision-making process that pilots undergo during flights. The flight simulator experience was a highlight of the seminar, providing students with a real-world perspective on the challenges and responsibilities of piloting an aircraft.

Case Studies: The final session of the seminar involved analyzing case studies related to the aviation industry. Led by Ms. Daisy Fathima and Mr. Rijo Johnson, students were encouraged to apply their knowledge to real-world scenarios, discussing various issues such as safety incidents, customer service challenges, and operational disruptions. The case studies provided an opportunity for students to engage in critical thinking, problem-solving, and collaborative discussion, helping them to consolidate their learning from the previous sessions.

ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON “UML & DESIGNING TOOLS”



The workshop began with an introductory session by **Mr. Affan H Basha, CEO, MD, Encapsulation Infotech Pvt. Limited, Mysore** who provided an overview of UML and its significance in the field of computer science.

The participants, comprising students and faculty members, were introduced to the basic concepts of UML, including its various diagrams and their applications.

Throughout the day, Affan H Basha developed the nuance of UML designing, covering topics such as use case diagrams, class diagrams, sequence diagrams, and activity diagrams. Participants were given hands-on training on using UML tools such as Microsoft Visio, Lucid chart and Star UML to create and analyze UML diagrams.

SEMINAR ON “VIRTUAL REALITY AND AUGMENTED REALITY IN HEALTH CARE

The BCA Department of the College organized an insightful seminar on “Virtual Reality and Augmented Reality in Health Care” on 4th September 2024. The seminar highlighted the importance of staying updated with technological advancements and their real-world applications, particularly in critical sectors like healthcare.

SEMINAR ON “EMERGING TRENDS IN CYBER SECURITY”

The resource person emphasized the significant role AI plays in enhancing cyber security measures and highlighted how AI is being used to develop security systems capable of identifying potential threats and taking proactive measures to prevent cyber attacks.
