## FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM



On January 31, 2026, the Post-Graduation Department of Commerce conducted a One-Day Faculty Development Program At The State Level, Titled "IPR Unlocked: Transforming Ideas Into Business Assets." Prof. Maruthi T. R., Director of the School of Law at the University of Mysore, served as the inaugural speaker for the



program. 83 faculty members from the various institutions, including Hindustan College, participated actively in the FDP. The program consisted of two academic sessions. Prof. Maruthi T. R. conducted the initial session, which concentrated on the fundamentals of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and established a robust conceptual framework. Prof. Jagadeesh, Professor and IQAC Coordinator at JSS Law College, Mysuru, conducted the second session. He focused on the advanced aspects of intellectual property rights (IPR) and their applicability in academia and business. The FDP was both successful and highly informative, thereby improving the participants' comprehension of intellectual property rights (IPR) as a strategic instrument for converting ideas into valuable intellectual assets.

## FDP ON SPSS FOR ACADEMIC RESEARCH



The Commerce Forum of the college organized a Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on “SPSS for Academic Research: Tools, Techniques and Interpretation” on 14<sup>th</sup> February 2026. The programme aimed to enhance the research capabilities of faculty members by providing practical knowledge of statistical analysis using the SPSS software. The session was delivered by Dr. Shilpa N.C., Professor, Department of MBA, St. Philomena’s College, Mysuru. She explained the fundamentals of the research process, including research design, hypothesis formulation, data collection methods, and questionnaire selection. The resource person also discussed reliability and validity testing techniques such as Cronbach’s Alpha, Test–Retest Reliability, and KMO and Bartlett’s tests. Various statistical techniques, including t-test, ANOVA, Chi-Square, correlation, and regression analysis, were explained with practical examples. The session also provided guidance on interpreting SPSS outputs for academic research and publications. The programme helped participants strengthen their understanding of statistical tools and improve their ability to analyse and interpret research data.

## A SPECIAL LECTURE ON “NAVIGATING MUTUAL FUNDS FOR SMART INVESTING”



The Department of Commerce organized a special lecture programme on 11<sup>th</sup> February 2026 at the college, Mysuru, for the UG Commerce students. ## INNOTHON2026, NATIONAL LEVEL INTER-COLLEGIATE IT EVENT



The Computer Science Department organized an Innothon as part of SPECTRA 2026, a National Level Inter-Collegiate Management, IT, Aviation & Cultural Fest held on 6th and 7th March 2026. The Innothon was an innovation-driven hackathon conducted over 8 hours, aimed at encouraging students to develop creative and practical solutions to real-world challenges.

The event began at 8:30 AM, where participants spent the initial 6 hours developing applications based on the theme **“AI-Driven Innovations for Social Impact and Sustainable Development.”** This was followed by 4 hours of project presentations. A total of 22 teams, comprising undergraduate, postgraduate, and engineering students, actively participated in teams of two members each.

The event was evaluated by jury members: Dr.Revathy, Assistant Professor & Head, Department of Computer Science Engineering, KCG College of Technology, Chennai, and Dr. Vignesh R. S, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science Engineering, Hindustan Institute of Technology and Science, Chennai. The jury assessed the teams based on creativity, innovation, design, functionality, and feasibility.

Participants demonstrated excellent technical skills, teamwork, and innovative thinking while addressing socially relevant problems. The event concluded successfully, providing a valuable platform for students to showcase their talents and promote collaboration, creativity, and impactful technological solutions.

### IT SKILL TRAINING PROGRAM

The Department of Computer Science, in association with ICT Academy and IBM SkillBuild, organized a four-day Advanced IT Skills Training Program on **“AWS Cloud”** from 19th to 22nd January 2026. The program was conducted by Mr. N. Sabarish Ramesh Kumar, Technical Trainer, IBM, Bangalore. A total of 40 students actively participated in the training, which featured a well-balanced blend of lectures, demonstrations, hands-on lab sessions, and assessments, ensuring both conceptual understanding and practical exposure.



Day 1 (19th January 2026) focused on the fundamentals of cloud computing, including an overview of AWS services, cloud economics, billing, and the AWS Shared Responsibility Model.

Day 2 (20th January 2026) covered key aspects of AWS security and networking, including Virtual Private Cloud (VPC) design, compute services, and hands-on practice with Amazon EC2.

Day 3 (21st January 2026) emphasized AWS storage and database services, such as Amazon EBS, S3, EFS,

RDS, DynamoDB, and Redshift.

Day 4 (22nd January 2026) focused on advanced topics including Elastic Load Balancing, CloudWatch, Auto Scaling, and cloud architecture best practices, followed by an assessment session to evaluate participants' learning outcomes.

The program significantly enhanced the students' technical competencies, industry readiness, and awareness of career opportunities in cloud computing.

### **SPECIAL LECTURE PROGRAM ON CORPORATE SOJOURN: GROOMING YOUNG MINDS”**



The Training and Placement Cell conducted a Special Lecture Program on “Corporate Sojourn: Grooming Young Minds” on January 27, 2026.
