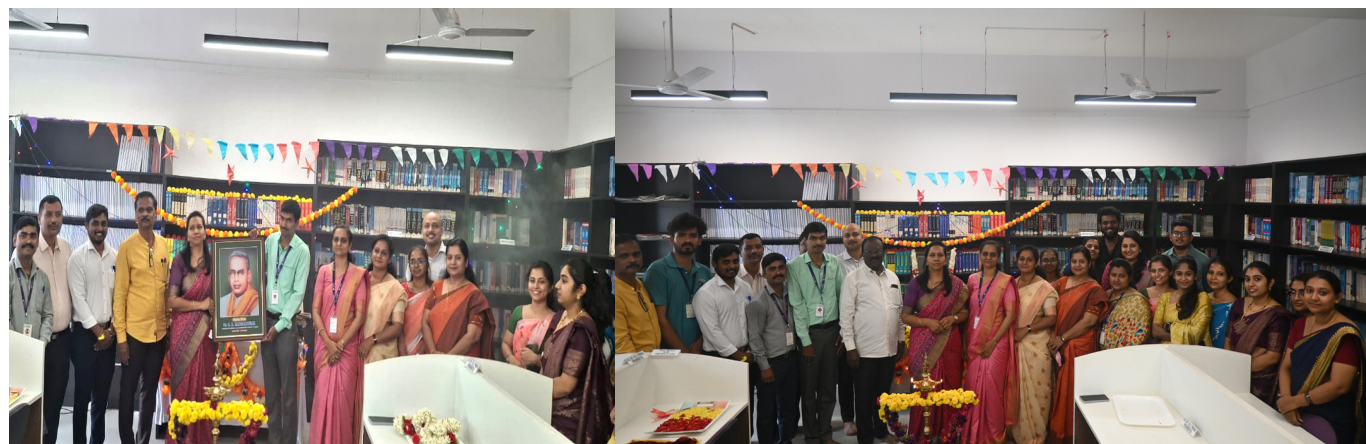

- * Day 4: Verbal aptitude covering vocabulary, grammar, sentence correction, and reading comprehension.
- * Day 5: Data interpretation, quantitative problem-solving, time management, and test-taking strategies.
- * Day 6: Mock aptitude test covering quantitative aptitude, logical reasoning, and verbal ability, followed by feedback and discussion.

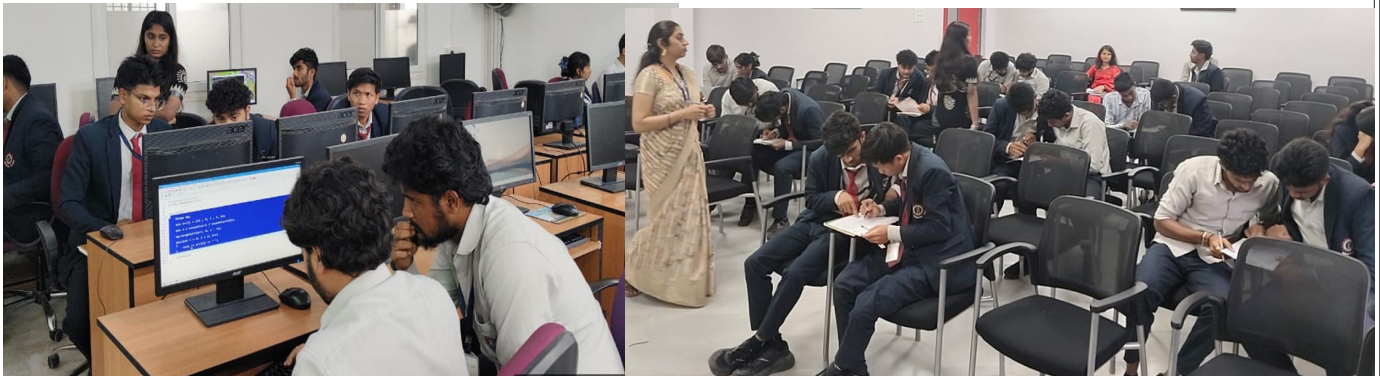
