This spaciouly designed lab is equipped with computers of latest configuration – Eighth Generation Computers with 4GB RAM and 1 TB hard disk.

Dr. Annie Jacob Verghese, Director, KCG College of Technology, Chennai inaugurated the newly constructed Fashion Design Lab. The Fashion Design course at Hindustan First Grade College offers the students to learn the techniques of Computer Aided Design (CAD), Professional Draping, Pattern Making and the design from concept to finished product. This program guides the students to become not only a designer with their own creative vision, but a professional prepared to take their place in this challenging industry.





The Fashion Design lab consists of the art facilities with Single Needle Lock Stitch Machines, Flat Bed Interlock Machines, Thread Over Lock Machines, Vacuum pressing machines, Embroidery Machines, Pattern Making Tables, Drawing Tables, Stitch Plus Cover Embroidery Machines, Full Mannequins and various dress forms with half dummy and full dummy. During the inauguration programme, the people who contributed for building the new block of HFGC and OFAA hostel were felicitated by the Chairperson Dr. Elizabeth Verghese.

APJ Abdul Kalam was a role model for the students and his life story that how a poor and deprived boy hailing from a village in Tamil Nadu, reached constitutional post in India, only because of hard work and sincerity which inspires students across the globe even today. The late leader was known for his love for students and focus on promoting education.

Kalam, a renowned scientist, made India proud with his missile

defence programme, but his favourite job was teaching and that's how he wanted the world to remember him. The long list of awards bestowed on Kalam include the Padma Bhushan in 1981 and Padma Vibhushan in 1990. He was later awarded the Bharat Ratna for his contributions to research, the field of science as well as his work with the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) and the Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO).

Among the many feathers in his cap is the successful testing of nuclear bombs at Pokhran. He was an author as well and his books include 'Wings of Fire', 'My Journey', 'Ignited Minds - Unleashing the Power Within India' and 'India 2020 - A Vision for the New Millennium'. Today the Hindustan Group has students from almost 40 countries from Mauritius and Africa on the western side to the Fiji Islands and Indonesia in the Far East. M.G. Ramachandran, Former Chief Minister of Tamilnadu was invited to inaugurate the Analytical Engineering and the Civil Aviation courses at HIET.

MGR complemented saying, “the aviation course is a specialized area, it requires a lot of technical know-how to make an aeroplane fly because we cannot repair aeroplanes in flight. The engineers have to be trained well so that the flights are safe.” The aero engine was fitted on a test bed with the popular and other instruments connected to it. When MGR started the engine Dr. K CG Verghese explained the function of each flight instruments to him. In 1994, when Dr KCG Verghese attended the seminar at the Cranfield University in the UK, he learnt how Britain’s Iron Lady, Mrs. Margaret Thatcher, had overhauled the education system in the late eighties when she was the prime minister. She called for meeting of the Vice Chancellors and the Management of private educational institutions and told them that she is going to pass an act which will empower all educational institutions to become Universities. This gave an impetus to the growth of the Education Sector in the UK.

Dr.KCG Verghese felt that there is something intrinsically wrong with our philosophy on education. He was of the opinion that, the man who is thirsty to get the water. The man who is thirsty for knowledge must be provided to the learning environment. This is what educational institutions are for according to the opinion of Dr.KCG Verghese. He did not see any justification in denying admission to a student who travels all the way from Kashmir and comes to Chennai seeking a chance to study aviation engineering, simply because he has only 59.5% marks and not 60%. Dr. K C G Verghese strongly felt that, if any student wants to be an Aviation Engineer, the desire alone will make him an engineer. A man becomes what he wants to be. He also strongly believed that every human being has infinite potential. The role of an educator is to bring out the best in every individual and that of an educational institution to provide the best facilities and the right ambience. to be continued...

CERTIFICATE COURSE ON "ART OF SEWING" AT HFGC

At present, the popularity of fashion designing is increasing more and more, consequently the demand of fashion designing course is rising. The huge requirement makes fashion designing feild as a ideal career option for many aspirants. The Department of Fashion Designing, Hindustan First Grade College offers Certificate Programme on "ART OF SEWING". Stitching is the basic skill which transforms the preconceived idea, which is expressed as "Design" into its practical usable form of "Garment" or a "Style". Stitchnng is the craft of fastening or attaching objects using stitches made with a needle and thread.



The course aims at imparting practical skills and theoretical knowledge of different stitches to the candidate & introduces the principles of drawing and designing.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM

- To impart skills in techniques of sewing and pattern making.
- To select suitable techniques for different styles and types of dress designs according to the latest trends.
- To illustrate and understand various types of garment sketches and techniques in making them.
- To provide the knowledge of industrial machines used for sewing.

PROGRAM DURATION

- The duration of the Certificate Programme shall be for **40 hours**.
- Classes will be conducted for 5 working days in a week from 21st November 2019 to 18th December 2019 with duration of 2 hours per day from 4.30 p.m. to 6.30 p.m.
- The programme is open to students, ladies and gents of all age groups.

COURSE COMPLETION REQUIREMENT

- The candidate has to take up the exam for the course completion which consists of **theory and practical** and it shall be in the ratio of **40:60** respectively.
- The candidate shall maintain a record of all the samples and garments in the prescribed size and scale.
- **Grade system is followed for assessing the skill of the candidates.**
- All candidates will be allotted grade and grade points in accordance with the marks scored by them.

CERTIFICATE COURSE STRUCTURE

- ✓ Basic Sewing Machine parts and their function. Introduction to basic operation of sewing machine practice on paper and fabric.
- ✓ Preparation of Sample to be practiced on Paper, Stitching On Fabric (Straight, Curves, Corners And Circular).
- ✓ Pattern Making Terminologies and Symbols (Notches, Punch/Circles), Pattern Information (Grain, Part, Piece, Cut Symbols), Seam Allowance, Fabric Terms (Grain, Bowing).
- ✓ Temporary Hand Stitches And Permanent Hand Stitches.
- ✓ Seam And Seam Finishes – Plain, Flat Fell, French Turned And Stitched, Lapped, Double Top, Pinked, Over Lock Stitches.
- ✓ Fullness and its types – Darts, Tucks, Pleats, Gathers, Shirring, Ruffles And Godets.
- ✓ Finishes-Neckline Finishes – Facing, Shaped Facing And Piping/Binding.
- ✓ Pockets (Patch Pocket, Weft/Bound, Set In Pocket/Side Seam Pocket).
- ✓ Working of Over Lock and Double Needle Lock Stitch Machine.
