VISIT TO RUDSETI

The III B.Com & III BBA students headed by Ms. Bhagyalakshmi.C, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce & Management and Mr.Raghunandhan, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce & Management visited RUDSETI (Rural Development & Self Employment Training Institute) Mysore on 07-01-2020. The visit aimed to provide an exposure to students about practical working of an EDP and how to be self-employed by undergoing a formal training. **Mr. N. G. Lakshman Rao, Director, RUDSETI** highlighted the importance of training, initiatives taken by Government to start EDP models, eligibility to apply for the training and about various short terms Entrepreneurship Skills Development Programmes. The students were informed about the steps to prepare a business plan, goal setting, and identifying competencies in business, opportunities & selection of business activities, team building, creating network, EDP model, post training follow ups, handling risk & how to put up a business project to avail loans from bank and other financial institutions. The Director briefed about EDP



relating to Agriculture, Product, Processing and general programmes and provided information about various micro finance schemes available to start small scale industries and grants given by Central and State Government to start business in India.

The students gained knowledge through interaction with Director of RUDSETI and with the people who are undergoing training. They witnessed the facilities available to undergo training. Government First Grade College, Honnali, Davangere District was invited as a resource person. The inaugural program commenced with a prayer by Mr. Shreyas. Mr. Manjunath, the resource person explained how human intelligence is processed by machines, types of AI, AI branches, applications of AI including expert systems, natural language processing (NLP), speech recognition and machine learning. He also discussed about pros and cons of various biometric data and described how the pattern recognition helps in AI. The Resource Person highlighted the role of Artificial Intelligence in Internet of Things (IoT) which is used to collect and handle the huge amount of data that is required by the Artificial Intelligence algorithms, in turn, these algorithms convert the data into useful actionable results that can be implemented by the IoT devices. He encouraged the students to take up real life problems and provide solutions using Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning techniques. Dr. S N Hegde, Former Vice Chancellor, University of Mysore and Dr. Suresha, Dept of Computer Science, University of Mysore expressed their inability to attend the meeting due to their pre occupation.

Dr . K.C.G.'s corner

Recap: Dr. K C G Verghese decided to import an aircraft which was banned in those days except for government use. As he had reasonable and strong grounds of running Aviation Institution approved by the Civil Aviation Department and earning substantial foreign exchange, with 400 international students studying various courses at HIET, Dr. Verghese filed an application with the Directorate General of Civil Aviation seeking for the permission.

Mrs. Indira Gandhi, Former Prime Minister enquired about the institution seeking to import the aircraft. When the Prime Minister was explained about the credibility and the future planning of the institution by Mr. Kapoor, the permission was granted to import Cessna 172 aircraft. Fortunately it was discovered that a German businessman wanted to sell a Cessna 172. He was using aircraft to shuttle to and from Singapore. Dr. Verghese had a ride in this aircraft at Kuala Lumpur airport and checked the various parameters and found that it was well maintained. A final deal was made to purchase the aircraft.

The rules of Reserve Bank of India did not permit the bankers to release the payment until the consignment reached India. After

returning to India, Dr. Verghese met the RBI officials and finally the bankers were permitted to issue a demand draft in favour of the seller. This experience of Dr. Verghese gave him necessary encouragement to go for commercial operation. Years later, Air Asia became the first private taxi operator in India to operate Boeing 737. Former Prime Minister Mr. Rajiv Gandhi, though a pilot himself, was not enthusiastic about the air taxi operations. However, he was instrumental in designing aviation policy that eventually lead to the operation of air taxis. Finally Dr. Verghese was permitted to operate with Fokker aircraft. (to be continued...)

FOUNDER'S MEMORIAL DAY

The 14th Founder's Memorial Day was observed on 14 February 2020. Homage to Late Dr. K.C.G. DR. K C G MEMORIAL CUP - STATE LEVEL INTER COLLEGIATE BOX CRICKET TOURNAMENT FOR MEN

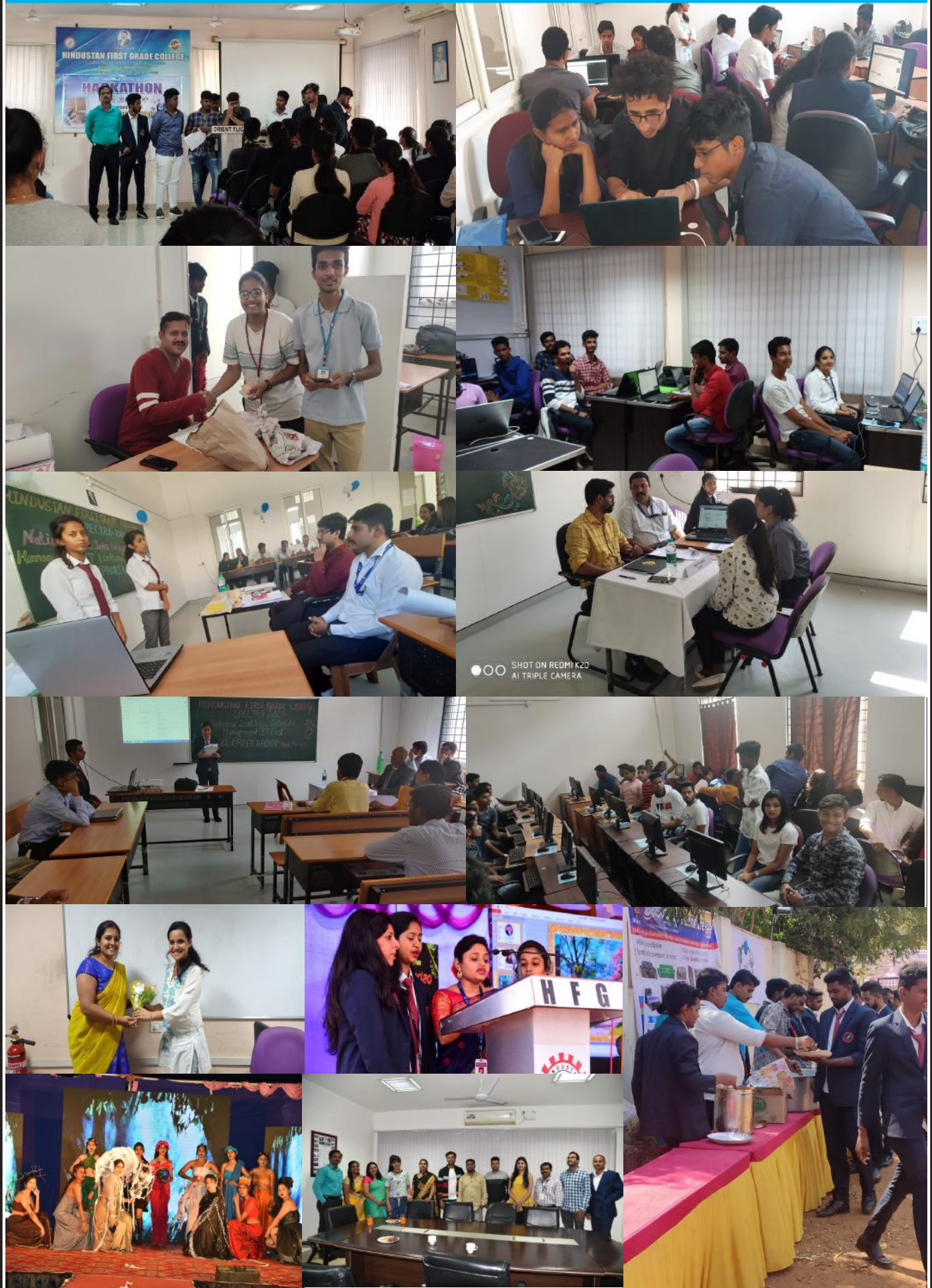

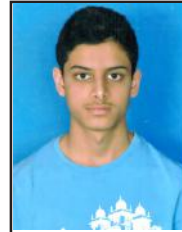
