



Arts College, Mysuru. The programme initiated with a Prayer Song by NSS Volunteers. Mr. Raghavendra C S, Assistant Professor, Department of Kannada welcomed the gathering. Dr. M P Varsha, District President, All India Consumer Welfare Council Mysuru, enlightened the gathering about the consumer rights and explained the benefits of Consumer Forum. He requested the members to be aware of the consumer rights and bring in to the notice of the forum, in any case of violence of the rules by the shops/ company. He also gave many examples/ case studies how the consumer forum has assisted the concerned consumer in claiming the rights.

Mr. Mahadeveswamy, Inspector, Legal Weight and Measurement Office, through a practical demonstration explained the ways, shop keepers cheat their costumers by using tricks in the weighing scales. He also highlighted the consumer rights and how the common public can file complaints against such mal practices. Prof. Manonmani, Head of Psychology Department, Maharani's College, Dr.C.J. Priya, Principal, Ms.Sukshma R D, NSS Coordinator, staff and students graced the occasion with their presence.

PANEL DISCUSSION: LIVING WITH COVID 19 AND BEYOND CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES

The Internal and Quality Assurance Cell in association with Y's men club of Mysuru Chamundi organized a Panel Discussion on "Living with Covid 19 and Beyond Challenges and Opportunities" on 30th December 2020. Dr. Mohan Appaji Koleyanda, Professor, Department





of ENT, Head and Neck surgery, KVG Medical College, Sullia, Dr Lokesh A J, Professor and HOD, Department of Medicine, Kodagu Institute of Medical Science, Coorg, and Mrs. Lovis T. V, Nursing Officer, Kodagu

Institute of Medical science, Coorg were invited as the panelists for the panel discussion. Dr. Mamatha M, Coordinator, IQAC welcomed the participants which was followed by Principal's address who highlighted the ill effects of the pandemic and the challenges faced by the common people during the pandemic.

More than 100 participants inclusive of academicians, Research Scholars, students and Parents participated in the discussion. Dr. Mohan Appaji Koleyanda briefed the Common Symptoms of Covid 19 and the first aid treatment. He explained in detail the preventive measures to be taken regarding home isolation guidelines, Home Remedies and Post Covid Management. He also gave safety tips, suggested immune boosters and explained importance of N95 masks and its important role in avoiding the spreading of virus.

Dr Lokesh AJ, Professor and HOD Department of Medicine, Kodagu Institute of Medical Science, Coorg, explained the type of treatment to be given at different stages, different type of diagnosis and testing done for detecting the infection, plasma treatment and therapies, quantity of intake of Vitamin C, D and Zinc, long term effect on the infected persons. He also informed about the vaccination, and its effectiveness on the mutant virus.

Mrs. Lovis T V, Nursing Officer, Kodagu Institute of Medical science, Coorg explained about the care to be taken for the Covid19 patients and gave valuable tips to the students to be taken as preventive measures which included three mantra's the students should follow to avoid Covid - wear the mask correctly, wash the hand frequently and importance of keeping physical distance. She also gave her suggestions on including immune boosters in the diet in order to avoid the pandemic effect.

During the discussion session, the faculties and students asked questions which were answered by the panelists. The webinar concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Mamatha M.

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Dr.K.C.G.'s corner

Recap: Dr. Verghese faced problem from his business partners which led to shutting down the operation of Air Asiatic. Later, with the solid support from his eldest son Anand, Dr. Verghese purchased U. S eightseated King Air aircraft. He got the approval to import of aircraft from Civil Aviation Department and the aircraft arrived at Chennai. Later he purchased the Beechjet which was an executive jet.



In 1994, Dr. Verghese started the Orient Flight School in Pondicherry. Initially Dr.Verghese thought of starting Orient Flight School at Sholavarm, but due to many hurdles he chose Pondichery. The Government of Pondicherry was keen on supporting Dr. Verghese's venture as the airport at Pondicherry had fallen into disuse after Vayudoot's shut down, their hopping flights to Chennai, Neyveli and Tuticorin.

Dr. Verghese happened to be the first person in South India to operate a private executive jet. As the vears passed, consistent hard work of Dr. Verghese lead to success. The OFS started by Dr. Verghese got recognition and many State Governments started selecting pilots trained by Orient Flight School. The school also attracted students from countries in Africa and the Arab world. The OFS had a fleet of 10 aircraft which included Beechjet, KingAir, C90-A, Piper Seneca, Cessna 152 and Cessna 172 and a charter division known as Orient flights.

Coincidently, there was an acute shortage of pilots, following the entry of new pilots in the airline sectors. The DGCA responded to this crisis by reducing the minimum hours required for obtaining a commercial Pilot's Licence (CPL). Dr. Verghese appreciated this step taken by DGCA. He was of the opinion that there would not be any threat to the safety if they reduced the hours, as the flying is safer than riding a motor bike or driving a car. The examinations conducted by DGCA were tough and the pilots were taking up the necessary hours of flying experience before they were granted licence.

On the Independence Day of 2005, when Dr.Verghese visited OFS, he was surprised and happy to find that among fifty-eight pilot trainees, five were girls. Those were the days when girls were not encouraged to learn flying.

One day, when Dr.Verghese was sitting in the HIET Office, Dr. Jeevaraj Alva, the then Education Minister of Karnataka came from Bangalore and expressed a desire to see the facilities of the lab, workshop and class of OFS. After his visit, he expressed his desire to start an aviation institution in Karnataka, similar to HIET as there was no such institution in Karnataka. As per the Minister's advice, Dr. Verghese with his team visited Bangalore and met Dr. Alva along with the Director Technical Education. of the Education Secretary and other Officials. Subsequently, he started the Electronics Academy and Aviation Institution in Karnataka. One morning, Dr. Verghese flew from Chennai to Coimbatore in a Cessna 172 aircraft. The young pilot with

impeccable credentials, who flew the plane was hired just a few days ago. The take off was smooth and calm weather permitted a peaceful flight. Dr Verghese spent some time talking to a co passenger and looking out of the window. Then he shut his eyes to have a brief nap. His morning siesta was rudely interrupted when the aircraft landed on tarmac with a great thud. The plane bounced into the air for three times and settled down on the third bump.

WEBINAR ON UNTOUCHABLE: A VOICE OF MARGINALIZED



The Department of English organised a Webinar on the topic "Untouchable: A Voice of Marginalized" on 16th December 2020. The webinar was based on the novel, Untouchable, written by Mulk Raj Anand, prescribed for the students of III Semester BCA. Dr. Usha B, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Government First Grade College, Kumta, Uttara Kannada District was invited as the speaker of the Webinar. The webinar initiated with a welcome address and introduction to the Resource Person by the Programme Convenor, Ms. Nagasri. S.

Dr. Usha, in her lecture, gave a detailed and comprehensive understanding of the novel, Untouchable. She explained the various dimensions of the practices prevailed in India, with reference to the protagonist of the novel - Bakha, who belonged to the Sweeper community. The speaker, through the character of Pandit Kali Nath tried to highlight the hypocrisy, snobbery and ostentation of the Upper Caste Hindus, who sometimes stoop very low to achieve their ends.

Dr. Usha gave a detail insight into the various characters like – Sohini, Lakha, Ram Charan, Chotu, Rakha – who, through their characters try to express great advocacy of marginalised and defenceless against their life - long humiliation and oppression. She concluded her lecture by recalling E.M.Froster's opinion about the possible solutions to eradicate the caste system and the differences that prevailed. The participants, during the Feedback session, expressed that the webinar was resourceful and the Webinar concluded with a thanking note, rendered by Ms. Nagasri, Assistant Professor, Department of English, HFGC.

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
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INSTALLATION CEREMONY OF Y'S MEN'S CLUB OF MYSURU YOUTH
