The Department of Computer Science, in association with ICTAcademy and IBM SkillBuild, organized a four-day Advanced IT Skills Training Program on “**AWS Cloud**” from 19th to 22nd January 2026. The program was conducted by Mr. N. Sabarish Ramesh Kumar, Technical Trainer, IBM, Bangalore. A total of 40 students actively participated in the training, which featured a well-balanced blend of lectures, demonstrations, hands-on lab sessions, and assessments, ensuring both conceptual understanding and practical exposure.

Day 1 (19th January 2026) focused on the fundamentals of cloud computing, including an overview of AWS services, cloud economics, billing, and the AWS Shared Responsibility Model. The resource person explained Amazon Web Services (AWS), cloud adoption strategies, and the AWS Cloud Adoption Framework (AWS CAF). Sessions covered AWS pricing models, Total Cost of Ownership (TCO), billing and cost management, AWS Organizations, and technical support. The day concluded with an overview of the AWS Shared Responsibility Model, emphasizing security responsibilities in the cloud.

Day 2 (20th January 2026) covered key aspects of AWS security and networking, including Virtual Private Cloud (VPC) design, compute services, and hands-on practice with Amazon EC2. The networking session introduced Amazon VPC, with activities on VPC design and a lab on building a VPC and launching a web server. An overview of Amazon Route 53 and Amazon CloudFront was also provided. The day concluded with Compute Services, covering Amazon EC2, hands-on EC2 instance management, cost optimization, container services, AWS Lambda, and AWS Elastic Beanstalk.

Day 3 (21st January 2026) emphasized AWS storage and database services, such as Amazon EBS, S3, EFS, RDS, DynamoDB, and Redshift.

Day 4 (22nd January 2026) focused on advanced topics including Elastic Load Balancing, CloudWatch, Auto Scaling, and cloud architecture best practices, followed by an assessment session to evaluate participants’ learning outcomes.

The program significantly enhanced the students’ technical competencies, industry readiness, and awareness of career opportunities in cloud computing.

POSTER MAKING COMPETITION



The Department of Computer Science, Hindustan College, Mysuru, organized **Inter-Collegiate Poster Making Competition on the theme “Cyber Insights”** on 28th January 2026 at 10.00 a.m. The event was conducted to encourage creativity, innovation, and awareness about emerging cyber technologies and digital security among students. The competition was open to PUC and Degree students, and participants took part in teams of two. A total of 44 students from various institutions actively participated in the event. The participants showcased their artistic talent, creativity, conceptual understanding of topics related to cyberspace, cybersecurity threats, and the future of technology.

The posters were evaluated by a panel of judges, Dr. Archana M V, Associate Professor, Department of Commerce and Management, HC and Ms. Sukshma R D, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science, HC. The evaluation was carried out based on predefined criteria such as creativity, relevance to the theme, clarity of message, innovation, and overall presentation. The judges appreciated the originality and thoughtful depiction of cyber-related concepts presented by the participants. The judges' decision was final. Based on the evaluation, the winners of the Poster Making Competition were announced as follows:

First Prize: Ananya AC and Joshwa Rai – Vidya Vikas College

Second Prize: Harshitha GJ and Akshantha SM – MMK & SDM College

Third Prize: Harshtha Sri SK and Hemanth R – MIT First Grade College

The Poster Making Competition provided an excellent platform for students to express their ideas creatively while enhancing their awareness of cyberspace and cybersecurity issues. The event successfully met its objectives and encouraged students to think critically about the digital world and its future.

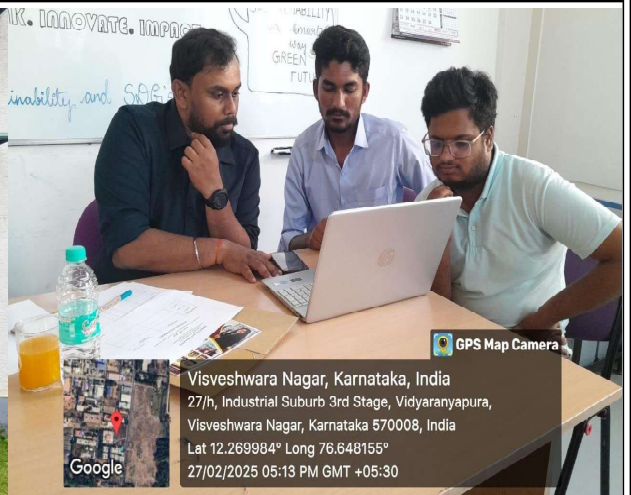

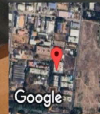
